# CHAPTER-I

## INTRODUCTION

### BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COMMISSION

**I.1** After attaining statehood on 25<sup>th</sup> January 1971, Himachal Pradesh established its own Public Service Commission on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1971 under Article 315 of the Constitution.

**I.2** The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations 1971 were notified by the Governor of Himachal Pradesh on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1971 under Article 318 of the Constitution of India. These Regulations provide that the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission shall consist of a Chairman and two Members to be appointed by the Governor. The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1974 were amended vide notification dated 17.01.1985 and the strength of members was increased from two to three.

Vide notification No. Per (AP.B) A(6)-1/2018 dated 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2018, the Government of Himachal Pradesh amended the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1974 and the strength of members was increased from three to five. Since the establishment of the Commission on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1971 many distinguished persons have occupied the offices of Chairpersons and Members. The detail is mentioned at **Appendix-I**.

### FUNCTIONS

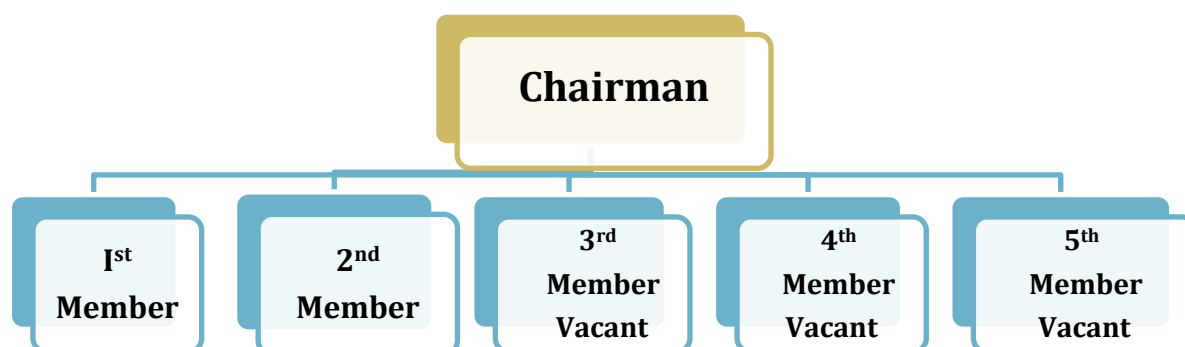
**I.3** The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission was set up under Article 315 of the Constitution of India to discharge the duties and functions, assigned to it under Article 320 of the Constitution. The underlying idea was to have within the State an independent and impartial Constitutional Authority which may give advice and recommendations on all matters referred to it. By virtue of the provisions made in the Constitution, the Commission is required to conduct examinations for appointments to the services of the state as decided by Government and to advise the State Government on all matters relating to framing of Recruitment and Promotion Rules, principles to be followed in making appointments, promotions and transfers from one service to another and in respect of disciplinary matters for Civil Servants under the state of H.P.

The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (**ADDITIONAL FUNCTIONS**) Act, 2018 (as assented to by the Governor on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2018) was notified by the Government of Himachal Pradesh on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 to entrust the additional functions to the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission with regard to making recommendations for recruitment of persons and advise regarding the service matters of various institutions viz. Boards and Corporations.

**I.4** The Commission also assists the Union Public Service Commission and the Staff Selection Commission in the conduct of various examinations, which are conducted within the State of H.P.

### COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION AND STAFF

**I.5** As on March 31, 2022 the Commission had one Chairman and two Members. The Organizational Chart of the Commission, name (s) of the Chairman and Members who remained as such during the period under report are as under:—

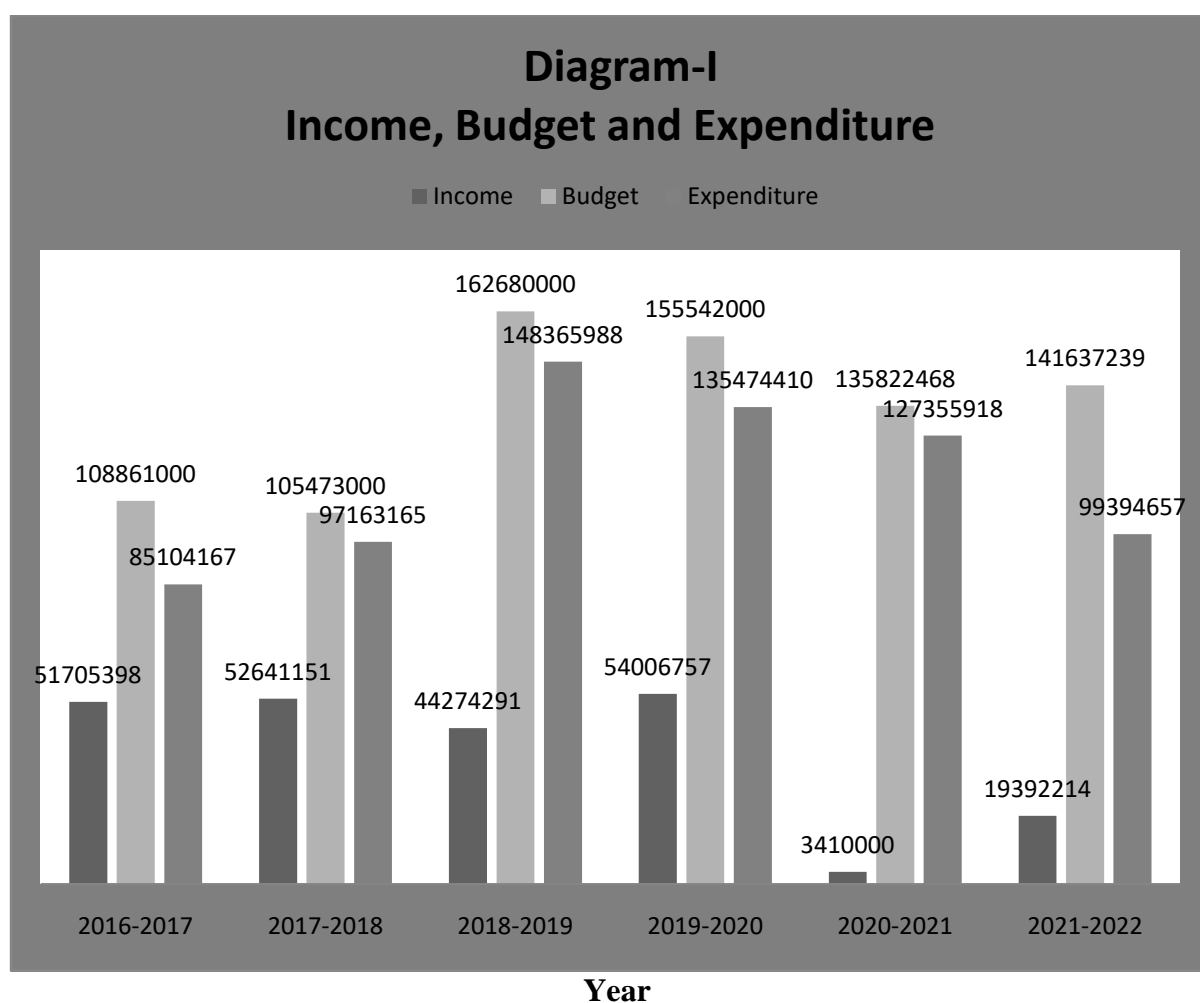

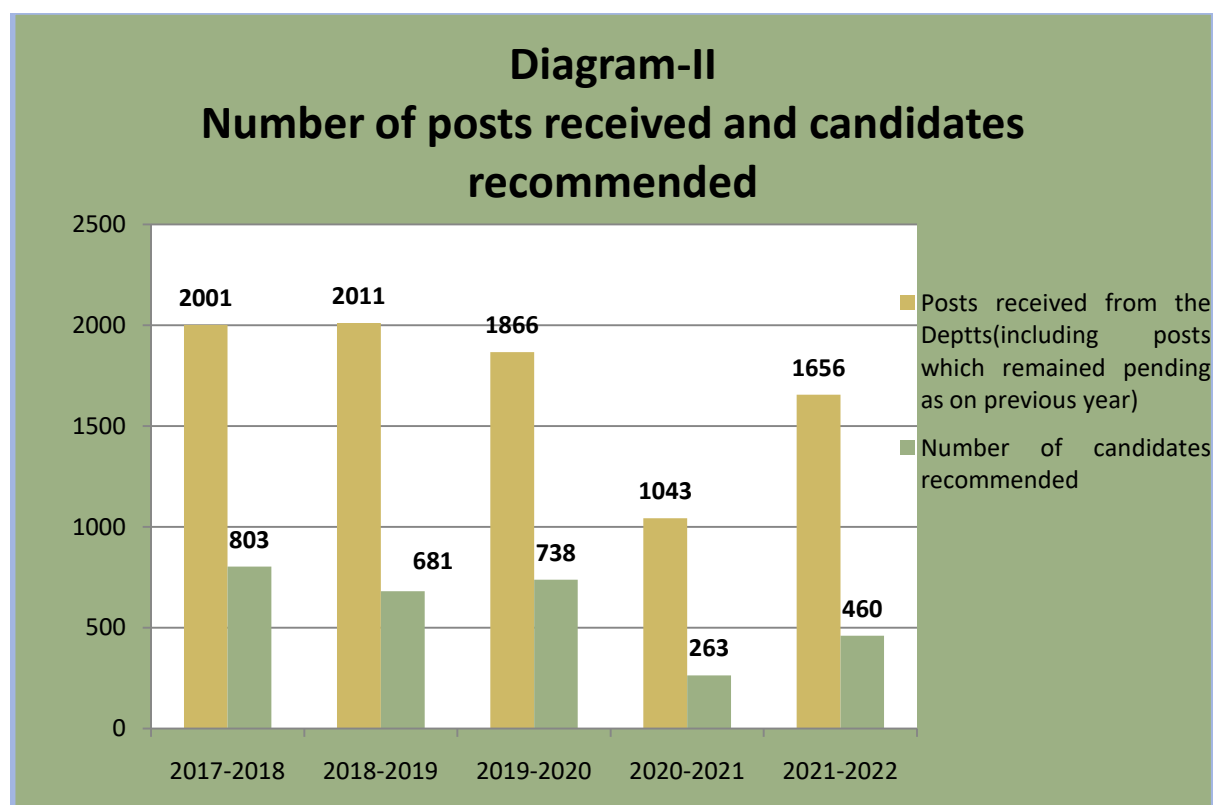
## **QUANTUM OF WORK**

In pursuance to the U.G.C. letter No.F.7-12/2017-(NET/SET) dated 14-06-2017, advertisement was issued to SET-2019 on 10.12.2019 vide advertisement 21/2019. Last date for applying for SET-2019 was 30.12.2019. In response to the advertisement, 29330 candidates applied for this test and 25691 candidates were admitted provisionally on claim basis and the candidature of 3629 candidates was rejected for want of examination fee. State Eligibility Test-2019 was held on 22.11.2020 in which 10519 candidates appeared in all three papers. The result of above mentioned examination was declared on 17.08.2021 in which 720 candidates were declared qualified. The certificates to the qualified candidates are being issued on receipt of documents in support of their eligibility.

## **CHAPTER-III**

### **SERVICE MATTERS**

**III. 1** In the discharge of its Constitutional obligations, the Commission continued to advise the State Government in matters pertaining to Recruitment & Promotion Rules, ad-hoc appointments, promotion matters, disciplinary cases and on other matters referred to it for its advice.

#### **RECRUITMENT & PROMOTION RULES**

**III. 2** The Commission received 07 proposals of draft Recruitment and Promotion Rules for various posts/ services from various departments of the Government. The Commission accorded its approval in five cases and two cases were pending during the year under report. (**Appendix-XII & Appendix-XIII**)

#### **DRAFT AMENDMENT TO RECRUITMENT & PROMOTION RULES**

**III. 3** The Commission received 38 cases of draft amendments to the notified Recruitment and Promotion Rules, out of which 25 cases were approved, 13 cases remained pending for want of complete information/ documents from the concerned department. (**Appendix-XIV & XV**)

#### **RELAXATION OF RECRUITMENT & PROMOTION RULES**

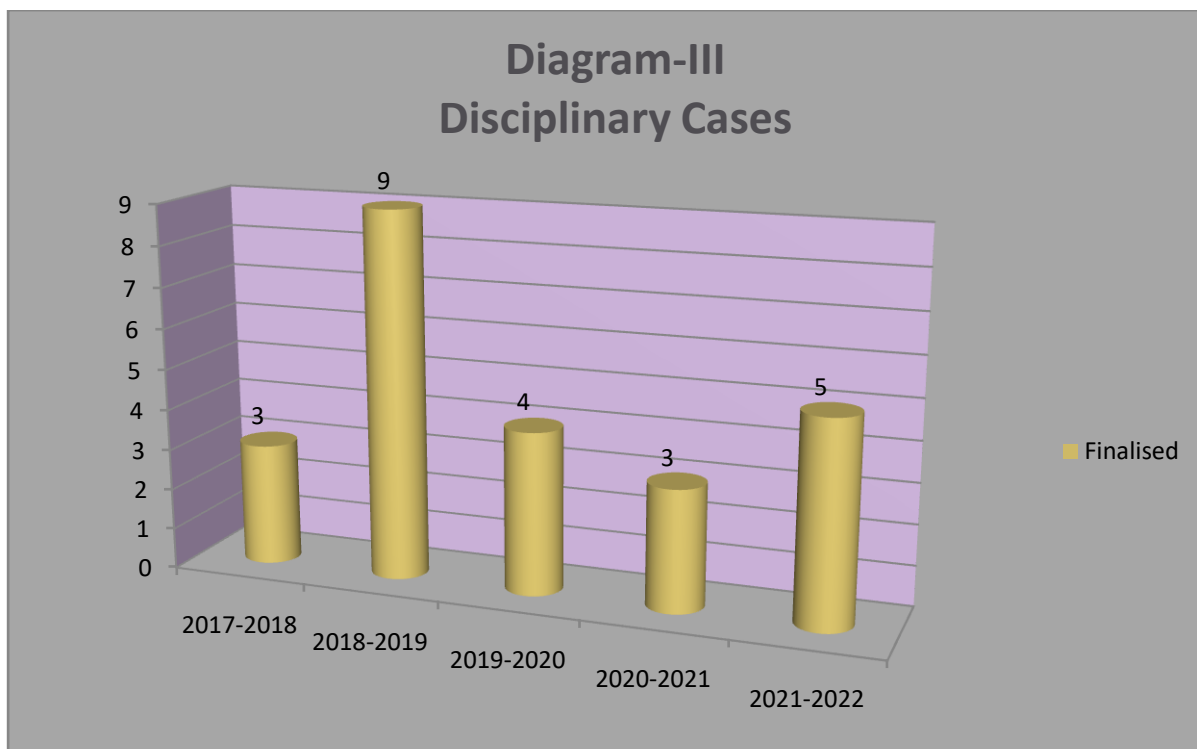
**III. 4** The Commission received 05 cases for relaxation of provision of Recruitment & Promotion Rules. The Commission accorded its approval in 02 cases and 03 cases were not approved. (**Appendix-XVI**)

#### **PROMOTION CASES**

**III. 5** During the year, the Commission finalized 81 cases of Departmental Promotion in respect of various departments involving 1073 officers (Gen-978, SC-76, ST-19). (**Appendix-XVII**) 07 cases of Departmental Promotion remained pending during the year under report. (**Appendix-XVIII**) The Commission has been impressing upon the Government not to resort to ad-hoc appointments and initiate timely action to fill up the posts in accordance with the provision of Rules.

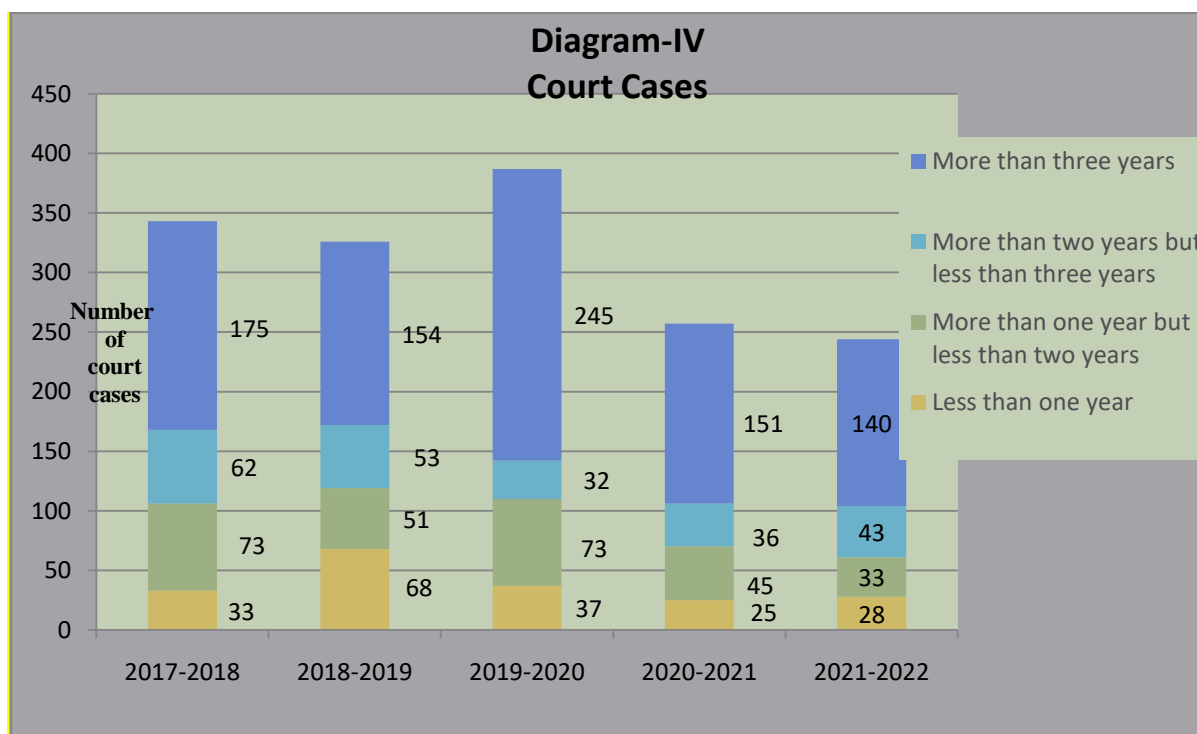
#### **DISCIPLINARY MATTERS**

**III.6** During the period under report, the Commission received 05 cases pertaining to disciplinary proceedings against officers for advice. All the 05 cases were finalized by the Commission. (**Appendix-XIX**). The disciplinary cases finalized by the Commission in last five years are shown in diagram-III.



## **COURT CASES**

**III.7** In all 244 cases remained subjudice in various courts during the year under report. Out of these 28 cases were of less than one year, 33 more than a year but less than two years and 43 more than two years but less than three years whereas 140 cases were pending for more than three years. During the period under report 44 cases were decided by different Courts.



## **CHAPTER-IV**

### **AD-HOC APPOINTMENTS**

**IV. 1. (i)** It has come to the notice of the Commission that some of the departments have resorted to making ad-hoc appointments to various posts and promoting officers without consulting the Commission by taking alibi to the provision of Regulation No.5 of the H.P. Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1973. These departments have not adhered to the instructions of the Government issued from time to time and the instructions contained in para-14 at page 35 of the H.P.P.S.C. Hand Book supplied to all the Administrative Departments. The relevant portion of these instructions is as under:—

“an ad-hoc appointment may be made in a permanent post (for a period not exceeding six months) without consulting the Commission only if, owing to an emergency having arisen, it is necessary in the Public interest to fill up the vacancy immediately and there is likely to be undue delay in making the appointment after consultation with the Commission. Where these conditions are not satisfied, consultation with the Commission is obligatory before making an ad-hoc appointment in a permanent post. This however, does not apply to ad-hoc appointment in a temporary post for a period not exceeding six months”

**IV-1 (ii)** Despite repeated requests made by the Commission and instructions issued by the Government for submission of half-yearly returns of the ad-hoc appointments, no return has been received from any department.

**IV-1 (iii)** During the year under report, the Government sought approval of the Commission for extension of continued ad-hoc appointments beyond six months, as also for ad-hoc appointments in the absence of Rules at the initial stage to various posts/services in one case and the same is not approved. **(Appendix-XX)**

### **NON-ACCEPTANCE OF COMMISSION'S ADVICE/NON CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSION**

**IV.2** The Commission is under a Constitutional obligation to give its advice to Government in all cases referred to it under Article 320 (3) of the Constitution of India. The commission noted with regret that in 01 case its advice was not accepted by the Government. Further, the State Government vide Personnel Department letter No. 2-11/71-Apptt. Dated 18.09.1974 had issued instructions that in cases in which the department concerned decides to differ from the advice of the Public Service Commission, it would be desirable that the department make another attempt at narrowing down the area of difference between the Commission and itself by making another reference to the Commission and only in case of irreconcilable differences, the matter may be put up to the State Cabinet for approval. In all such cases, it is desirable that the matter may be processed through the Department of Personnel at the time of getting the approval of the cabinet as it is the Department of Personnel which has to prepare the grounds and give justification for differing from the advice of the Public Service Commission's when the Annual Report of the Commission is placed before the Legislature. Through these instructions of the Government are being followed strictly by some Departments but some Departments have-not followed the same as is apparent from the following cases:—

As per standard procedure in such type of cases consultation with the Commission is always a pre-requisite. Since the AD has deprived the Council of Ministers Meeting (CMM) of the valuable advice of the Commission, therefore, it decided to treat this action of AD as a case of non-consultation with the Commission to be reported in its next annual report.	



## CHAPTER-V

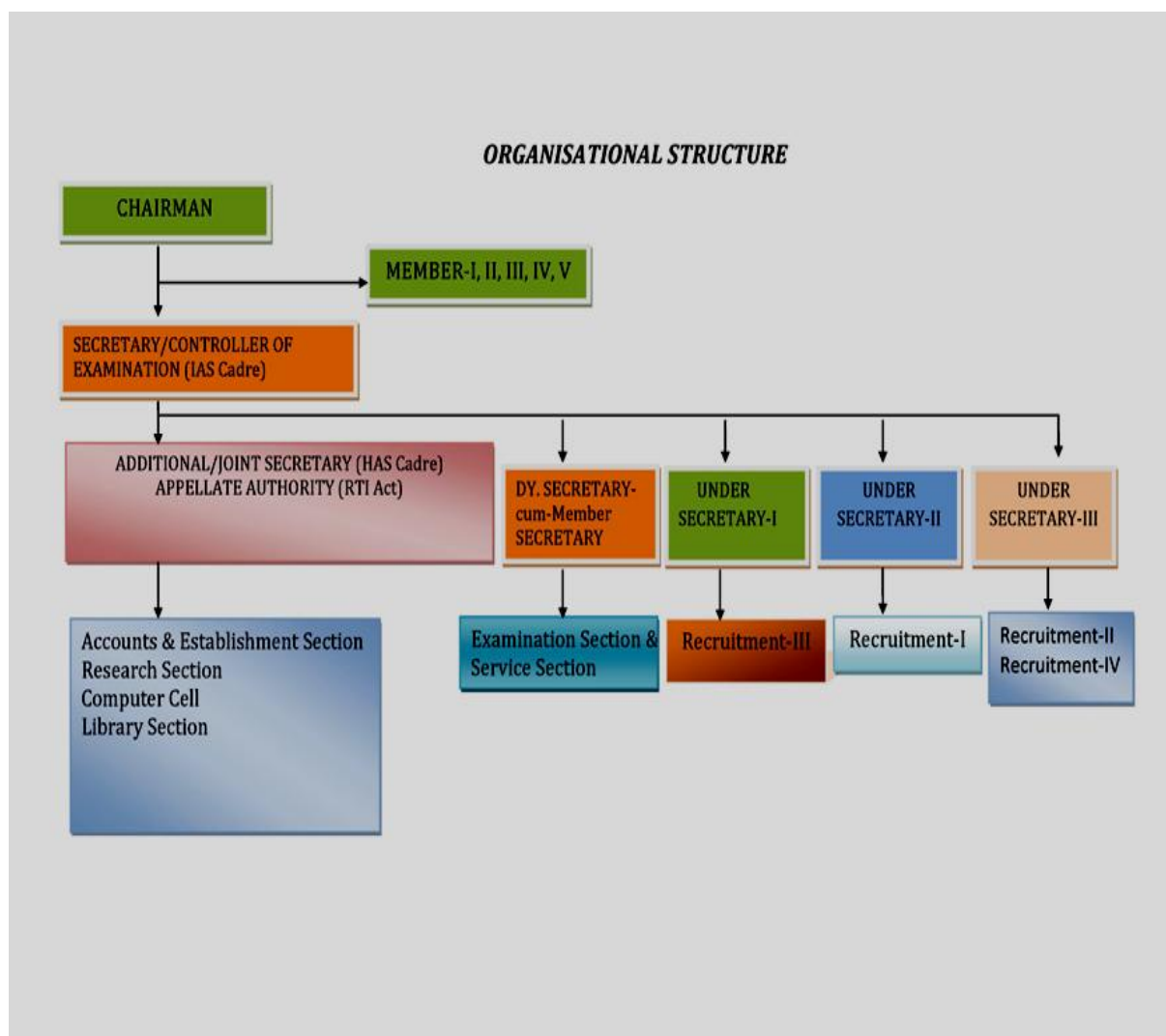
### IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT

#### V.1 Organization and functions

The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission came into existence on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1971 and brief history of the Commission has been given in paras I.1 & I.2 of Chapter-I of this report in detail. The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission was set up under Article 315 of the Constitution of India to discharge the duties and functions assigned to it under Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

#### V.2 The powers and duties of its officers and employees

The functions and duties of the Union and State Public Service Commissions have been defined under Article 320 of the Constitution of India. The Secretary is the Head of the office and therefore controlling officer as per H.P.F.R. The Chairman is the Head of the Department. The Organizational Structure of this Commission is as under:-



### **The Commission consists of nine branches/Sections:**

1. Accounts & Establishment Section 2. Recruitment-I Section 3. Recruitment-II Section 4. Recruitment-III Section 5. Recruitment-IV Section 6. Service Section 7. Examination Section 8. Research Cell 9. Computer Cell.

#### **V.3 The procedure followed in the decision making including channels of supervision and accountability.**

There are three levels at which decisions on different matters are taken i.e. Secretary, the Chairman and the Commission.

The proposals or any references/ representations etc. received from different quarters are put up by concerned Assistants and submitted to the Section Officer which is the first channel of supervision. After examination at the level of Section Officer, the matter is again submitted to the Branch/ Branch Officer *i.e.* Under Secretary and Deputy Secretary who submits all matters through Deputy Secretary/ Joint Secretary/ Additional Secretary/ Special Secretary of H.A.S. cadre as the case may be. The Deputy Secretary/ Joint Secretary/ Additional Secretary / Special Secretary of H.A.S. cadre (as the case may be) submit the case to the Secretary of I.A.S. cadre. If the Secretary is competent to dispose of the matter then it is not sent to the further channel i.e. the Chairman. The Chairman is the last channel of supervision.

Applications received from candidates for different posts are admitted at the office/ Secretary level as per rules and conditions put in the advertisement. Only those applications are put up to the Commission for orders where specific need for such orders is felt by the Secretary. The Chairman may direct any matter to be placed before the Commission. Any advice on service matter sought by the Government is placed before the Commission and communicated accordingly. The interviews are taken by the Chairman himself or any other Member or Members as assigned by him. The meeting of D.P.C. is presided over by the Chairman or Member thereto, to be nominated by him.

#### **V-4 The norms set by it for the discharge of its functions**

Functions and duties of the Union and State Public Service Commissions have been defined in Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

Duties and functions of supervisory officers and other staff are well defined in the Office Manual which is ipso facto applicable on the employees and supervisory officers of the Commission. However, for the discharge of its functions relating to Recruitment/ Examinations etc, required norms are fixed by the Secretary in consultation with Commission. Such norms etc. are also reflected in the Rules of Business, instructions issued from time to time and different decisions taken by the Commission in this direction.

#### **V-5 The Rules, Regulations, Instructions, Manuals and Records held by it or under its control or used by its employees for discharging its functions.**

The Rules of Business, the H.P.P.S.C. Hand Book, decisions of the Commission, instructions issued time to time by the Commission and the Govt. are used for discharging different duties by the employees/ officers of the Commission. For dealing with establishment, Budget/ Travelling Allowance/ L.T.C./ G.P.F./ M.R. claims, store & Stationery, following Rules / Manuals etc. are also followed :—

**V-7** The particulars of any arrangement that exists for consultation with, or representation by, the members of the public in relation to the formulation of its policy or implementation thereof:—

There is reception counter in the office of the Commission. Every information which can be given to the candidates/public is available. However, if any candidate wishes to discuss a matter or seeks further clarification, he/she can meet higher authorities. Further if a candidate wants reply of any information in writing, the reply can be given to him on his/her representation. Candidates/public have no direct say in the formulation of policy or implementation thereof but the suggestions of public on different issues are always taken into consideration.

The following procedure of dealing with such applications (applications received under the Right to Information Act, 2005) is adopted in the Commission's Office:—

- (a) Like other application, such applications are received by the receptionist whether received by post or by hand. Receipt of by hand application is given by the receptionist to the information seeker as usual.
- (b) After receipt of application(s) by the receptionist, the application (s) is given immediately to the Research Cell i.e. Public Information Cell.
- (c) The Assistant Public Information Officer gives the application to the dealing assistant who immediately put it up after making necessary entries in register number-I to the APIO who further submits it to the PIO.
- (d) The PIO takes decision on every such application as per Rules/Act and decision of the Commission.
- (e) Where necessary, matter is put up to higher authorities for clarifications/orders.
- (f) Every type of record is made available by the Section Officers and Branch Officers to the APIO/ PIO to facilitate for providing information.
- (g) When the desired information is ready it is immediately supplied.
- (h) Inspection of all type of record permissible to be inspected by the information seeker is done in the presence and room of the PIO.
