Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission has decided to hold HPAS Combined Competitive Main Examination-2014 at Shimla w.e.f. 12.09.2015 to 23.09.2015 in two sessions i.e. 10.00 AM to 1.00 PM and 2.00 PM to 5.00 PM. The detailed date sheet is available on our official website <http://www.hp.gov.in/hppsc>. The Admission letter- cum-admit cards are being sent shortly to all admitted candidates.

Expressing satisfaction over the timely holding of HPAS Combined Competitive Main Examination-2014, Sh K.S. Tomar, Chairman, H.P. Public Service Commission said “due to coordinated efforts and systematic planning, the one year gap, in declaring final result of Main Examination of HPAS Combined Competitive Examination, stands eliminated”. He lauded the efforts of the officers and staff of the Commission which enabled to reduce the gap period of holding the main written examination by more than one month as compared to the previous year.

25,248 candidates appeared in HPAS Preliminary Examination-2014 held on 07/06/2015 of which 612 candidates were declared qualified for main written examination of HPAS.

The candidates who had been declared qualified in the Preliminary Examination were advised to download the format of HPAS (Main) Examination-2014, application form and instructions to the candidates for filling up the detailed application form so as to send the same along with requisite examination fee and documents to the office of HPPSC on or before 24th August, 2015, failing which their candidature was liable to be cancelled. Only 566 candidates have applied out of which the candidature of 555 candidates have been admitted provisionally.

Sh. Tomar further stated “On 24th August, 2013, Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission had started Toll Free Centre to enable the Government to Citizen (G2C) interface for the quick delivery of information and public amassing the information through Help Centre. Toll Free Number 1800-180-8004 is being answered by a team of Help Centre Executives on every working day and the calls are attended by highly experienced and skilled professionals.”

He said, “Till date 24180 Calls on Toll Free Number 1800-180-8004 and 19331 Calls on help desk Telephone No. 0177-2629738 have been received. In all 43511 calls were received by the help centre.”
