CHAPTER -1

ORGANISATION

Brief History

1.1 Himachal Pradesh was formed as a union territory on 1st November 1956. Kangra and most of the hill areas of Punjab were merged with Himachal Pradesh on 1st November 1966. Thereafter on 25 January, 1971, Himachal Pradesh was declared as 18th State of India..

1.2 The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1971 was notified by the Governor of Himachal Pradesh on 8th April, 1971 under Article 318 of the Constitution of India. These Regulations provide that the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission shall consist of a Chairman and two Members to be appointed by the Governor. The Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1971 was amended vide notification dated 17.01.1985 and the strength of members was increased from two to three. Government of Himachal Pradesh Vide notification No. Per (AP.B) A(6)-1/2018 dated 15th January, 2018, further amended the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (Members) Regulations, 1974 and the strength of members was increased from three to five.

Functions of the Commission

1.3 The functions and duties of the Union and State Public Service Commission have been defined under Article 320 of the Constitution of India. These include:

- (a) Conduct of Examinations for the services of the State.
- (b) Direct Recruitment by selection through interviews.
- (c) The Commission shall also be consulted in:-
 - (i) Appointment of Officers on promotion /deputation/Absorption.
 - (ii) Conduct of Departmental Promotion Committee meetings.
 - (iii) Framing and amendment of Recruitment Rules for various services and posts under the Government of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (iv) On any matter referred by the Governor of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (v) Disciplinary Matters.









Number of vacancies advertised and candidates recommended for the period from 01 April, 2013 to 31st March, 2024.



RECRUITMENT BY EXAMINATION (WITHOUT VIVA-VOCE)

II.15 The Commission advertised 30 posts (UR-18, UR (OH)-01, SC-05, ST-03, OBC-03) vide advertisement no. 57/09/2022 dated 08.09.2022 for inviting online application from desirous and eligible candidates for HPF and AS Preliminary Competitive Examination-2022. In response to this advertisement, total 2330 application were received and the candidatures of 2305 candidates were admitted provisionally on claim basis. Out of these candidates, 1302 candidates appeared in screening test held on 26.02.2023 and 1003 candidates remained absent. Out of these, 304 candidates qualified for HPF & AS (Main) Examination. The Main Examination held w.e.f. 26-09-2023 to 28-09-2023, the result of the Main Examination declared on 16-01-2024, in which 30 candidates declared qualified and recommended.



- h. Inspection of all type of record permissible to be inspected by the information seeker is done in the presence and in the room of the PIO.

CHAPTER-V

APPOINTMENTS & MEETINGS

ADHOC APPOINTMENTS

V. 1. (i) It has come to the notice of the Commission that some of the departments have resorted to making adhoc appointments to various posts and promoting officers without consulting the Commission by taking alibi to the provision of Regulation No.5 of the H.P. Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1973. These departments have not adhered to the instructions of the Government issued from time to time and the instructions contained in para-14 at page 35 of the H.P.P.S.C. Hand Book supplied to all the Administrative Departments. The relevant portion of these instructions is as under:—

“an ad-hoc appointment may be made in a permanent post (for a period not exceeding six months) without consulting the Commission only if, owing to an emergency having arisen, it is necessary in the Public interest to fill up the vacancy immediately and there is likely to be undue delay in making the appointment after consultation with the Commission. Where these conditions are not satisfied, consultation with the Commission is obligatory before making an ad-hoc appointment in a permanent post. This however, does not apply to ad-hoc appointment in a temporary post for a period not exceeding six months”

V-1 (ii) Despite repeated requests made by the Commission and instructions issued by the Government for submission of half-yearly returns of the ad-hoc appointments, no return has been received from any department.

V-1 (iii) During the year under report, the Government sought approval of the Commission for extension of continued ad-hoc appointments beyond six months, as also for ad-hoc appointments in the absence of Rules at the initial stage to various posts/services in one case and the same is not approved. (**Appendix-XIX**)
