

HIMACHAL PRADESH PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

(Instructions to Candidates for Personality Test for the post(s) of Assistant Professor (College Cadre), Class-I (Gazetted) (on contract basis) in the Department of Higher Education, H.P.

Note: Candidates are advised to follow SOPs/ guidelines issued by the Government of Himachal Pradesh (in the Department of Revenue-Disaster Management Cell) and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India from time to time with regard to COVID-19 pandemic.

1. With reference to your application for the post of **Assistant Professor (College Cadre) Class-I (Gazetted) (on contract basis) in the Department of Higher Education, H.P** and after security of documents, you have been provisionally admitted to the said post and now the Personality Test for this post will be held as per date and time mentioned in the e-Call Letter in the office of the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission, Nigam Vihar Shimla-171002.
2. That you should ensure your presence in the H.P. Public Service Commission on the day of Personality Test (date and time indicated in e-admit card) **at 08:30 A.M. and 10.30 A.M respectively** i.e. on the day of Personality Test for verification of documents before appearing in the Personality Test Board.
3. The fact that you have been invited for Personality Test does not confer any right on you for selection against the post.
4. Please bring original Degree and Result-cum- Detailed Marks Certificates/ Sheet along with attested copies of the following documents with you:-
 - (i) Matriculation certificate showing your date of birth.

(a) Essential Qualifications:-

- (i) A good academic record with at least 55% marks or an equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed in Masters Degree level in the relevant subject from a Indian University or an equivalent degree from Foreign University recognized by the Government of India.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% is provided from 55% to 50% marks, at the Masters Degree for the SC/ST categories.

AND

- (iii) A relaxation of 5% (from 55% to 50%) of marks, at the Master's level to the Physically and Visually Handicapped persons in appointment as Assistant Professors.
- (iv) A relaxation of 5% is provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have passed their Masters degree prior to September, 1991.
- (v) "B" in the 7 point scale with letter grades O,A, B, C, D, E & F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed (7 point scale is displayed in the Foot Note).
- (vi) Candidate besides fulfilling the above qualifications should have cleared the eligibility test (NET) for Assistant Professor conducted by UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited the State Public Service Commission.
- (vii) "NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor in Universities / Colleges / Institutions.

Provided that the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Byelaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent position in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- (b) Evaluation of the Ph.D thesis by at least two external examiners;
- (c) Open Ph.D viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- (d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- (e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his /her Ph.D work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions)."

b) Desirable Qualification:

Knowledge of customs, manners and dialects of Himachal Pradesh and suitability for appointment in peculiar conditions prevailing in the Pradesh.

5. Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe or latest (valid) Other Backward Class certificate on the prescribed form, if you belong to any of these categories. The S.C. / S.T / O.B.C. certificate should be based on **parentage basis**. The candidates belonging to Ex-servicemen category shall bring discharge certificate & other related document issued by the competent authority as a proof of being Ex-serviceman.
6. **"No Objection Certificate"** from your present employer in case working on regular basis in Government /Semi Government Organization. **Without N.O.C.** you will not be allowed to appear before the Personality Test board and no further time will be allowed to produce N.O.C.
7. A latest **Character certificate** from a responsible Officer (Gazetted Officer of Government / Semi Government Organization) and **other Character certificate** from Head of the Institution last attended.
8. You should download **Attestation Form** through the link provided in the Personality Test Call Letter and bring it with you duly filled in all respect and also **bring two (extra) passport size recent photographs duly attested by the same authority who attests your Attestation Form** on the day of Personality Test.
9. Any other certificates of your academic qualifications etc. in support of your eligibility for the post as required as per Commission's **Advertisement**.
10. Your eligibility in terms of Essential Qualification(s) and experience etc. shall be reckoned as on the closing date (last date) for submission of online recruitment applications (ORAs) i.e. 06-06-2022. In respect of equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement, then the candidate is required to produce order/ letter in this regard, indicating the Authority (with number and date).
11. Your admission to the Personality Test is purely provisional subject to the verification of your eligibility as per rules / instructions.
12. Onus of proving that you are eligible for the post is on you only. If the date of notification / declaration of result is not indicated in the certificate / degree / marks list, the date of issue of certificate / degree / marks list shall be deemed as date of acquiring essential qualification.
13. If you fail to produce any of the certificates mentioned above, which is necessary to determine your eligibility and/or you are found ineligible vis-à-vis qualifications, you will not be allowed to appear before the Personality Test Board and no further time will be allowed to produce any document.
14. Besides, your eligibility will be subject to the conditions given in **Advertisement**.
15. No T. A. / D.A. will be paid for appearing in this Personality Test However, 30% discount is allowed by the H.R.T.C. in ordinary buses only for attending the Personality Test as per communication received from HRTC and discount will be applicable for only three days i.e. one day before and after the Personality Test for to & fro journey.
