(Instructions to Candidates)

The candidate must read the following instructions. Failure to comply with any instruction will render him / her liable to such action as the Commission may deem fit to take under the facts and circumstances:-

Note: Examinations conducted by the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission come under the purview of Himachal Pradesh Prevention of Malpractice Act, 1984.

- 1. H.P. Subordinate Allied Services (Main) Examination -2023 is being conducted by the H.P. Public Service Commission for all provisionally admitted candidates who have been declared qualified in Preliminary Examination -2023.
- 2. The date sheet for the H.P. Subordinate Allied Services (Main) Examination -2023 is as under:-

Note:

- (i) Entry to examination hall is strictly prohibited without valid e-Admit Card & valid identity card. Candidate must also bring one photocopy of their e-Admit Card and present the same in subsequent sessions.
- (ii) No candidate shall be admitted to the Examination Hall/Room after scheduled time of the commencement of the Paper. No candidate will be permitted to leave the examination Hall until the expiry of full time of examination.
- (iii) Candidates will be subjected to physical frisking before entering hall. Candidate's cooperation is solicited.
- 3. The scheme of Main examination is already mentioned in the advertisement No. 45/12-2023 dated 31-12-2023 (available on the official website of the Commission) of H.P. Subordinate Allied Services (Main) Examination -2023.
- 4. The candidate shall enter the examination Hall / Room one hour before the scheduled time for the commencement of the Examination. The Question- Cum-Answer Booklet / Answer Booklet will be supplied to him/her by the Invigilator 05 minutes before the actual time prescribed for the commencement of the paper.
- 5. The candidate must write his Roll No. and other details only in the space provided in the Question-cum-Answer Booklet/Answer Sheet. Do not disclose your identity in any manner such as by writing Roll No., Name, Mobile Number, Address etc inside the Question-cum-Answer Booklet/Answer Sheet.

- 6. The candidate shall not bring any article such as loose paper, books, notes, programmable calculators, slide rules etc. into the examination hall/ Room. He / She is also not permitted to carry pager, mobile phone or any other type of gadget / electronic device in the Examination Hall / Room. Any infringement of these instructions will entail disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.
- 7. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables / costly items in the examination hall / room, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. Commission will not be responsible for any loss in this regard. The candidates are allowed to carry only permitted examination articles i.e. Pen / Pencils / Admit Cards / Identity Proof / Copies of Photographs.
- 8. To maintain test integrity, only authorized persons and candidates with valid admit cards may enter the examination area. Accompanying individual must wait outside designated boundaries.
- 9. No candidate will be permitted to leave the examination hall/room until the expiry of full time.
- 10. Use of Scientific (non-programmable type) calculators is allowed and if considered necessary may be brought by candidates. Programmable type calculators are, however, not allowed in this examination.
- 11. The candidate who has disability of 40% or more and is not in position to read or write shall have the discretion of opting for his / her own scribe/ reader by making prior request in writing along with disability certificate issued by the competent medical board in support of his/ her claim to the Controller of Examination 07 days before the examination/test. Such candidate who will avail the assistance use of scribe/reader shall be given 20 minutes per hour, compensatory time.
- 12. The candidates have been provisionally admitted to appear in H.P. Subordinate Allied Services (Main) Examination -2023, scheduled as mentioned in paragraph 2 above. However, please note that:
 - (a) Your candidature is subject to verification of eligibility criteria at any stage of the selection process and thereafter.
 - (b) If found ineligible, your candidature may be cancelled/rejected without prior notice.
- 13. The candidate's admission to this Main Examination is purely provisional. The candidate should ensure that he/she fulfill all eligibility conditions for admission to Main Written Examination. The admission letter does not imply that the candidature has finally been approved / cleared by the Commission or that the entries made by the candidate in their online application for the Main examination have been accepted by the Commission as true and correct.
- 14. The candidate should bring his/her e-Admit Card downloaded from the website of the Commission in the examination centre. The candidate should paste self attested latest passport size photograph on the e-Admit Card in the space provided for the purpose. No candidate will be allowed / entertained to appear in the Examination without his/ her e- Admit Card with photograph. Discrepancy, if any, in the e-Admit Card be brought to the notice of the Commission.
- 15. Candidates are solely responsible for the secure storage/ custody/safe keeping of their e-Admit Card. In the event that a candidate's e-Admit Card is used by another individual to gain unauthorized admission to this examination, the candidate shall bear the burden of proof to

demonstrate that they did not engage or collude with an impersonator.

- 16. The candidate should note that his/her name in the e-Admit Card might have been abbreviated due to technical reasons. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by the Commission.
- 17. Consumption of alcohol / psychotropic drugs / smoking and taking tea etc. is strictly prohibited inside the examination Hall / Room.
- 18. The candidate must abide by the instructions as may be given by the Centre Supervisor / invigilator of the examination.
- 19. The candidate will furnish such necessary and correct information as may be asked for, from him/her in the examination hall by the Invigilator/ Deputy Supervisor/ Centre Supervisor.
- 20. While going to the toilet the candidate should turn his/her Answer Book / Question- Cum-Answer Booklet upside down.
- 21. The candidate must cross the page(s) left blank in his/her Answer Book / Question- Cum-Answer Booklet or Supplementary Answer Book, as the case may be, after attempting the last question during the allotted time in each paper of examination. All parts of a question should be attempted at one place.
- 22. Category claimed by candidate in his/her online application as well as shown in his/her e-A dmit Card will not be allowed to be changed.
- 23. Re-evaluation or rechecking of Answer Book / Question- Cum-Answer Booklet is not permissible nor the Commission enter into correspondence in this regard.
- 24. No candidate shall go outside the examination hall / room for any purpose, whatsoever, without prior permission of the Centre Supervisor.
- 25. No candidate shall go to the toilet during the last 10 minutes of the examination.
- 26. The candidate should note that he / she should not stand near or loiter in and around the examination Hall / Room after being permitted to leave on conclusion of the examination in each session.
- 27. A candidate is allowed to appear only in the examination centre allotted to him / her.
- 28. No T.A / D.A. will be paid for appearing in the H.P. Subordinate Allied Services (Main) Examination -2023.
