

**HIMACHAL PRADESH PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**  
**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR THE POST(S) OF CDPO'S AND TEHSIL WELFARE**  
**OFFICERS**

1. On the basis of claim furnished by you in your application form, you have been provisionally admitted to appear in the Screening Test for the post(s) of CDPO's and Tehsil Welfare Officers, (Preliminary) Examination-2013 Class-II, Gazetted, in the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment Deptt. H.P. and your candidature is liable to be cancelled if you are found to be ineligible for the post(s) at any stage of the selection process or thereafter.
2. Your candidature will be cancelled if you do not possess the Essential Qualification i.e. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized University.
3. Your eligibility in terms of Essential Qualifications shall be reckoned as on the last normal date of receipt of application i.e. 13-11-2013.
4. Onus of proving that you are eligible for the post is on you only. If the date of notification/declaration of result is not indicated in the certificate /degree/marks list, the date of issue of certificate/degree/marks list shall be deemed as date of acquiring essential qualification.
5. If you fail to produce any of the certificates which is necessary to determine your eligibility and /or you are found in eligible vis-à-vis qualification, your candidature is liable to be cancelled.

**The Screening Test will be of General Knowledge of 120 marks (objective type) duration of two hours as per following syllabus:-**

- a) History, Geography and Socio Economic development of Himachal Pradesh. **=50 Marks**
  - b) Knowledge of current events of National and International importance and such matters of every day observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person who has not made a special study of any scientific subject. **= 40 Marks**
  - c) Paper will also include questions on Modern History (From 1857 onwards) of India, Indian culture, Indian Polity, Indian Economy, Geography of India. **= 30 Marks**
6. You are advised to reach the Examination Centre on the day, 20 minutes before the commencement of the Screening Test. You will not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall 10 minutes after the commencement of the Screening Test and will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the expiry of full time.
  7. You are advised to write/encode on the Carbonless OMR (answer sheet) Commission's copy upper part with black / blue ball pen irrespective of the instructions contained on the answer sheet, if any.
  8. The Carbonless OMR Answer Sheet contains two parts i.e. upper part (Original) Commission's copy and lower part i.e. candidates copy. The candidates will retain carbonless copy i.e. candidate's copy with them and to handover the original Commission's copy OMR Answer Sheet (upper part) to the respective invigilator on the conclusion of the examination.
  9. You should bring your admission letter cum identity card in the Examination centre. The candidate should paste latest passport size photograph duly attested in case the scanned photograph is not appearing in the Candidate's Attendance sheet. No candidate will be allowed/entertained without photograph.
  10. Please mention your category in the answer sheet as already claimed by you in your application as well as shown on your admit card. Category once claimed at the time of application will not be allowed to be changed.
  11. No. T.A. /D.A. will be paid for appearing in the Screening Test.
  12. The answer key of this screening test shall be displayed on the official Website of the Commission after freezing the answer sheets. The objections, if any, received within seven days will only be entertained.
