INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. On the basis of claim furnished by you in your application form, you have been provisionally admitted to appear in the Screening Test for the post(s) of **Lecturer, Electronics & Communication Engineering** Class-I, (Gazetted), on contract basis in the Department of Technical Education H.P. and your candidature is liable to be cancelled if you are found to be ineligible for the post(s) at any stage of the selection process or thereafter.
2. Your candidature will be cancelled if you do not possess the Essential Qualification i.e. 1st Class Master's Degree in **Electronics & Communication Engineering / Technology** from a recognized Institute/ University.

OR

1st Class Bachelor's Degree in Electronics & Communication Engineering /Technology or equivalent valid GATE score minimum 75 percentile. To complete M.Tech./M.E. within 05 years failing which the increments will be stopped until the postgraduate degree is earned. The institution shall provide adequate opportunity to its teaching staff to complete this requirement. QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE FOR CANDIDATES FORM INDUSTRY & PROFESSION will be as above.

3. The eligibility of the candidates in terms of Essential Qualifications and experience etc. shall be reckoned as on the last normal date of receipt of application i.e. 13-06-2012.
4. The Screening Test will be of two hours durations of objective type of 100 questions. Out of which 80 questions will be of multiple choice of Bachelor's Degree in Electronics & Communication Engineering/Technology and 10 questions will be of General knowledge of H.P. and 10 questions of General knowledge of all over world.
5. You are advised to reach the examination centre on the date, 30 minutes before the commencement of the Screening Test. You will not be allowed to enter the examination Hall 10 minutes after the commencement of the Screening Test and will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the expiry of full time.
6. You are advised to write/encode the OMR (answer sheet) with black/blue ball pen irrespective of the instructions contained on the answer sheet, if any.
7. You should bring your admission letter cum identity card in the examination centre. The candidate should paste latest passport size photograph duly attested by the Gazetted Officer. No candidate will be allowed/entertained without photograph.
8. Please mention your category in the answer sheet as already claimed by you in your application as well as shown on your admit card. Category once claimed at the time of application will not be allowed to be changed.
9. No. T.A. /D.A. will be paid for appearing in the Screening Test.
10. The answer key of this screening test shall be displayed on the official website of the Commission after freezing the answer sheets. The objections, if any, received within seven days will only be entertained.
