INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR THE POSTS OF RANGE FORESTS OFFICER, CLASS-II (GAZETTED) (IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTS), ADVERTISED VIDE ADVERTISEMENT NO. 4/2017 DATED 23-03-2017 SUBSEQUENT CORRIGENDUM DATED 21-06-2017 & ADDENDUM DATED 28-07-2017.

Very Important:-

- 1 The candidate will only write his/her Roll No., Name of candidate, category, Examination name, Centre, Subject/Paper and Date on the outer sheet (of pink colour) attached with the Answer Book and not to write anything on the title Page of the Answer Book/ supplementary Book(s).
- 2 All the candidates will hand over a copy of NOC duly issued by present employer (appointing authority) along with UNDERTAKING FOR NUMBER OF CHANCES ALREADY AVAILED for above mentioned posts, valid OBC certificate covering the entire period from last date of submission of online recruitment applications till date of interview alongwith an undertaking that his /her status as OBC has not been changed and he/ she has not been excluded from the category of OBC of H.P. on account of being covered under creamy layer on the day of entrance examination to the respective invigilator in the examination hall / rooms failing which their candidature will be cancelled.
3. The candidate shall not bring any article such as loose papers, books, notes, electronic or any other type of calculators, log tables, slide rules etc. into the examination hall. He / she is also not permitted to carry in the examination hall / room pager, mobile phone or any other type of gadget / electronic device for communication, as arrangement for their safe custody cannot be assured. Therefore, the candidate should ensure that they are not in possession of any kind of such articles / devices before they enter the premises examination hall.
4. The examination shall include two compulsory and two optional papers.
5. The candidate shall not change his optional subjects opted by him on online recruitment application form.
6. A candidate shall answer the optional papers in English or Hindi only which is at his /her option choice.

Note: RULES RELATING TO THE SUBJECTS AND STANDARDS OF THE COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION for the said posts have been mentioned in the Advertisement No. 4/2017 dated 23rd March, 2017 subsequent Corrigendum dated 21st June 2017 & Addendum dated 28th July, 2017, therefore, candidates are advised to go through the same to avoid any confusion in this regard.

The candidate must read the following instructions carefully. Failure to observe any instruction will render him/her liable to such action as the Commission may deem fit to take under the facts and circumstances:-

1. You have been provisionally admitted to appear in **MAIN WRITTEN EXAMINATION(s)** for said posts being conducted by the Commission w.e.f. 22nd July, 2018 to 30th July, 2018 from 10.00 A.M to 01.00 P.M. in single session except two sessions on 22nd July, 2018 i.e. 10.00 A.M. to 01.00 P.M. & 2.00 P.M. to 05.00 P.M.. **(Except 23-07-2018)** on the basis of claim furnished by you in your Online Recruitment Application.
2. Your admission to this Main Written Examination is purely provisional. The candidate should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions for admission to examination. The admission letter does not imply that your candidature has finally been approved / cleared by the Commission or that the entries made by you in your online application for the entrance examination have been accepted by the Commission as true and correct.
3. Your eligibility in terms of age, essential qualification, category and experience etc. shall be reckoned as on the last / normal date of receipt of online application i.e. 07-08-2017.
4. Onus of proving that you are eligible for the above mentioned Examination lie upon you only. If the date of notification / declaration of result is not indicated in the certificate / degree / marks list, the date of issue of certificate / degree / marks list shall be deemed as date of acquiring essential qualifications. If you fail to produce any of the certificate(s) which is necessary to determine your eligibility and / or you are found ineligible vis-à-vis age, qualification, category claim and experience etc., your candidature is liable to be cancelled.

5. You are advised to reach the examination centre on the scheduled date at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the Entrance Examination. The candidate shall enter the examination Hall / Room 20 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of the Entrance Examination. You will not be allowed to enter the examination hall / room 30 minutes after the commencement of the Paper in each session. The Answer Book will be supplied to you 20 minutes before the actual time prescribed for the commencement of the Paper in each session. No candidate will be permitted to leave the examination Hall / Room till the expiry of HALF TIME.
6. The admission letter will be supplied to the candidates in the Examination Centre. The list of centre (Roll No. wise) and instructions to the provisionally admitted candidates have been uploaded on the website of the Commission i.e www.hppsc.hp.gov.in/hppsc and the candidates have also been informed through SMS/ e-mail on their respective Cellular Nos. and e-mail; ID(s) as mentioned by them in the Online Recruitment Application Forms.
7. You are responsible for safe custody of Admission Letter and that, in the event of your Admission Letter being used by any other person for securing admission to this entrance examination, the onus lies upon you only to prove that you have not procured the services of an impersonator.
8. The candidate should note that his/her name in the Admission Letter might have been abbreviated due to technical reasons. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by the Commission.
9. The Commission does not supply any article of stationery except authorized Answer Book / Supplementary Books for use in the Examination.
10. Smoking and taking tea is strictly prohibited inside the examination Hall / Room.
11. While going to the toilet the candidate should turn his/her Answer Book upside down.
12. The candidate will furnish such necessary and correct information as may be asked for, from him /her in the Examination Hall by the Invigilator / Deputy Superintendent / Centre Superintendent.
13. Carrying or uses of Mobile Phones, Pager or any other communication device are banned in the examination venue.
14. The candidate must cross the page(s) left blank in his/her Answer Book or Supplementary Answer Book, as the case may be, after attempting the last question during the allotted time in each paper of examination. All parts of a question should be attempted at one place.
15. Category claimed by you in your online application as well as shown in your admission letter will not be allowed to be changed.
16. You are informed that this examination has been brought under the purview of the H.P. Prevention of Malpractices Act, 1984 and therefore, all such candidates who are apprehended while taking the examination will be dealt with the provisions of the said Act.
17. Re-evaluation or rechecking of Answer Books is not permissible nor the Commission enter into correspondence in this regard.
18. No candidate shall go outside the examination hall / room for any purpose, whatsoever, without prior permission of the Centre Superintendent.
19. No candidate shall go to the toilet during the last 15 minutes of the examination.
20. The candidate should note that he / she should not stand near or loiter in and around the examination Hall / Room after being permitted to leave on conclusion of the examination in each session.
21. A candidate is allowed to appear only in the examination centre allotted to him / her.
22. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
23. No T.A / D.A. will be paid for appearing in the Entrance Examination.
